

UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS (Sayılamayan isimler)

Sayılamayan isimler tek tek sayamayacağımız ve çoğul hali olmayan isimlerdir.

food, water, milk, lemonade, juice, tea, coke, coffee, chocolate, sugar, salt, time

SOME (Birkaç/Biraz)

Olumlu cümlelerde miktar belirtirken sayılamayan isimlerle biraz anlamında sayılabilen çoğul isimlerle birkaç anlamında **some** kullanırız.

We have some orange juice.

There is a little water in the glass.
(Bardakta az miktarda su var.)

A LOT OF (Çok)

Hem sayılabilen hem de sayılamayan isimlerle birlikte genellikle olumlu cümlelerde çok anlamında **a lot of** kullanırız.

There are a lot of guests at the party.
(Partide çok misafir var.)




